The choir was honoured to have been selected from a number of choirs nationally, to participate in the 2009 Commonwealth Observance Ceremony at Westminster Abbey - a very special event which celebrates the amazing work and relationships between the nations of the Commonwealth.

The observance service took place in the presence of Her Majesty the Queen and representative dignitaries from all of the 53 member states of the Commonwealth.

Early January saw the choir work straight into their newest adventure in support of the brilliant civil-rights play "Rainbow Beach" This gave them a fantastic opportunity to add their music to a live drama setting and allowed some of them to exhibit their thespian talents as well.

In 2008 the choir took part in the following high profile events:

- The Royal Exchange Theatre, Manchester to sing and film for a new all-star BBC drama called All the Small Things hitting BBC1 in early 2009.
- A long-awaited expeditionary tour in Germany.
- Contribution towards the Massed Choirs at the spectacular opening of Liverpool's European City of Culture celebrations.

Other events include appearing in BBC's Advent show 'Christmas Voices' and in June 2005 the choir made history by taking part in the recording of The Best Gospel Album In the World Ever...! at Abbey Road studios London. This is the first gospel album ever to be released by a Major UK label - EMI.
